



Children's Camps

Dear Families,

Welcome to the Canton Museum of Art's art camp! Here are a few museum policies that we believe will be helpful to know so that everyone has a safe, fun, and educational experience at CMA!

Morning session- 10:30-12:30 / Afternoon session-1:30-3:30 / Full day session- 10:30-3:30

Lunch: If your student is attending all day, please bring a drink/s and a non-refrigerated lunch that does not need to be reheated.

Student Drop-Off

Students may be dropped off no earlier than 10 minutes prior to camp. Families must walk their child to the front desk for check-in and then walk their student to their classroom.

Student Pick-Up

Please pick your student up promptly at the end of camp. Families must check out student/s at the front desk and their teacher. If there is a specific person you would like us to only allow to pick up your student, please indicate their name/s on the form below. A student must be picked up no later than 10 minutes after camp. The museum is not available to extend its hours and instructors are not available to stay late. An additional \$25 fee for every 15 minutes late will be charged to have a staff member stay to watch your student.

Clothing

Please send your student in clothes that you don't mind getting messy. For heavy messes, please feel free to send your student with an extra shirt to wear over clothes. Our thermostat may be cold or hot at times. Wearing layers is strongly encouraged. Small bags are allowed for lunches and other necessary items.

Accessibility

We are committed to providing an inclusive and welcoming environment for all children. To help us provide the best experience for your child, please include any relevant information about their individual needs, sensory sensitivities, medical history, allergies, medications, or other conditions that our instructors should be aware of in the following form.

Medication & Allergies

Please notify your instructor of any allergies or medications that your student may have on the first day of class. Our instructor will hold doctor-approved medications if needed in the classroom for safe keeping.

Sickness

If your child becomes ill during class, the emergency contact will be called. An adult should be available to pick up the child **at all times**.

Emergency Care

For minor injuries, first aid will be administered, and if necessary, families will be notified. For severe injuries, your child will be taken to the nearest hospital. Parents will be notified as soon as possible.
